

Pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 10904© and 49 C.F.R. 1152.27(c)(2)(I), hereby formally express  
its intent to file an offer of financial assistance by purchasing the 11.29 line miles of  
railroad proposed to be abandoned.

By copy of this Notice, Oregon Pacific & Eastern Railroad Company, pursuant  
to 49 C.F.R. 1152.27(a), asks the Yakima Interurban Lines Association to provided it  
with copies of the most recent parasail, title reports, physical condition of the line, the  
carrier's estimate of the net liquidation value of the line, with supporting data, including  
but not limited to all identifications of the parcels of land underlying the rights-of-way  
which are owned in fee and those which are easement grants, the lengths and widths,  
weight of rail and the condition of the relay rail, re-roll and scrap rails, the reusable and  
scrap ties, and any other information deemed relevant to calculate the net liquidation  
value of the lines and the minimum price which the railroad seeks.
