It was recently brought to my attention that the Verified Notice of Exemption dated February 8, 2007, filed under Docket Numbers AB 32 (Sub. No. 93X) and AB 355 (Sub. No. 26X), contained an error in that Docket No. AB 32 (Sub. No. 93X) had previously been utilized in connection with another proceeding. The correct Docket Number should read as follows: Docket No. AB 32 (Sub. No. 95X). Moreover, I was further advised that an additional filing fee would be required where the Verified Notice of Exemption was submitted by two (2) separate entities under two (2) separate Docket Numbers. Accordingly, enclosed with this correspondence is a check in the amount of \$3,100.00 representing the additional filing fee.

Additionally, please be advised that the above referenced oversight with respect to the Docket Number resulted in a delay in the filing of the Verified Notice of Exemption. Consequently, the April 1, 2007 proposed consummation date should be amended to reflect a proposed consummation date of April 9, 2007 so as to ensure full compliance with 49 CFR § 1152.50(d)(2).

In closing, I apologize for the aforementioned oversights and thank you for your time and continued cooperation.
