

Dear Mr. Williams:

The "Supplemental Statement" filed by PYCO Industries, Inc. (PYCO) on August 14, 2007 is proof again that PYCO will not be outdone in the volume of paper filed at the Board. This time a 3-paragraph letter generated a 9-page PYCO Supplemental Statement.

The Supplemental Statement changes nothing. West Texas & Lubbock Railway is welcome to come onto SAW's property to maintain and repair track in accordance with its duty under 49 C.F.R. § 213.5(e). No protocol amendment or other Board order is necessary for that. PYCO is not welcome on SAW's tracks, the same as any other shipper does not belong on rail carrier property. As usual, PYCO attempts to ascribe a sinister motive to that, but it is standard practice in the rail industry.
