

Abandonment of Trackage Located in Green Island, NY

On August 31, 2007 counsel for Delaware and Hudson Railway d/b/a Canadian Pacific Railway ("D&H") advised that it will require additional time to comply with the request of R. Freedman & Son ("Freedman") to more fully respond to the request for information required by 49 CFR 1152.27 (a)(1) concerning the line proposed to be abandonmend in this proceeding. D&H indicated that it is not opposed to a request by Freedman to toll the time to submit an offer of financial assistance ("OFA") until thirty (30) days after D&H has provided the requested additional information.

Since the requested information is deemed essential to submission of an appropriate OFA, Freedman respectfully requests the Board to toll the time for submission of an OFA until thirty (30) days after D&H has provided the requested information.
