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
Pursuant to the decision served on April 10, 2008, the Board reinstated the procedural schedule in the above-entitled proceedings. The staff of Missouri & Northern Arkansas Railroad Company, Inc. ("MNA") has been dealing with the flooding of its lines in Missouri during the past several weeks. Because of the dedication of personnel to restoring rail service in the aftermath of the floods, MNA will not be able to obtain all of the documents needed to respond to the discovery sought by Railroad Salvage & Restoration, Inc. and G.F. Wiedeman International, Inc. (jointly "Petitioners") by April 18, 2008.

Counsel for MNA and Petitioners have conferred and agreed to a modification to the schedule announced by the Board today. The parties respectfully request the Surface Transportation Board to extend the date for the completion of discovery to April 30, 2008, and to extend the date for Petitioners to file their opening statements to June 3, 2008. The remainder of the schedule would stay the same.
