Dear Ms. Brown:

On May 17, 2010, North Shore Railroad Company ("North Shore") filed a Verified Notice of Exemption under 49 U.S.C. §1150.41 to acquire a rail operating easement over approximately 6 miles of rail line in Luzerne County, PA owned by PPL Susquehanna, LLC, a non-carrier. On June 3, 2010, the Board requested that North Shore file additional information to enable it to determine whether or not the easement afforded North Shore sufficient ability to carry out its common carrier obligations and requested that North Shore provide additional information concerning the status of the subject rail line.

North Shore has compiled the information requested by the Board but has not had an opportunity to have that information reviewed and confirmed by representatives of PPL Susquehanna, LLC. Accordingly, we request that the June 23, 2010 filing deadline for this information be extended an additional thirty (30) days so that North Shore can complete necessary coordination and confirmation of this information with PPL Susquehanna, LLC.
