RE: Proposed Abandonment of the El Dorado Subdivision from Milepost 457.0 near Gilcrest to Milepost 460.6 near El Dorado Junction, a distance of 3.6 miles in Ouachita County, Arkansas; STB Docket No. AB-33 (Sub-No. 222X)

Dear Ms. Brown:

This is to advise that in accordance with 49 CFR 1152.29(e)(2), as of June 10, 2010, the Union Pacific Railroad Company, ("UP") with regard to the subject Abandonment Exemption, has consummated the abandonment of the El Dorado Subdivision from Milepost 457.0 to Milepost 460.6 near Gilcrest, a distance of 3.6 miles in Ouachita County, Arkansas, (the "Line") pursuant to authority granted in the Surface Transportation Board's ("Board's") Decision originally served June 30, 2006. A copy of this notice is being served concurrently with the Arkansas Public Service Commission.

In accordance with the Board's Decision originally served June 30, 2006 after reopening the proceeding, prior to commencing any salvaging activities, UP did make all consultations required by the Board's Decision and completed the Section 106 process under the National Historic Preservation Act, 16 U.S.C. 470(f) as evidenced by the Board's Decision served on September 28, 2006 in this docket.
