

PETITION TO REJECT OR REVOKE

---

Preliminary Statement

Samuel J. Nasca<sup>1/</sup> for and on behalf of United Transportation Union-New York State Legislative Board (UTU-NY), petitions the Surface Transportation Board (STB) to reject the notice of exemption (Notice), filed August 31, 2010, by Middletown & New Jersey Railroad, LLC (M&NJ). If the notice is not rejected, the STB should revoke the exemption. 75 Fed. Reg. 56653 (Sept. 16, 2010).

Background

M&NJ became a carrier if and when it commenced operations after filing a notice of exemption to acquire a 6.5-mile line between Middletown and Slate Hill, NY, from Middletown and New Jersey Railway Co., in F.D. No. 35227, Middletown and New Jersey Railroad, LLC-Acquisition and Operation Exemption-Middletown & New Jersey Railway Co., Inc., 74 Fed. Reg. 11995-56. (Mar. 20, 2009).

Concurrently, Regional Rail, Inc., filed a notice of exemption to control M&NJ and East Pen Railroad, LLC (ESPN) in F.D. No. 25228, Regional Rail, LLC-Continuance in Control Exemption-Middletown and New Jersey Railroad, LLC, 75 Fed. Reg. 11996 (Mar. 20, 2009). The notices were filed to become effective on or after April 5, 2009.<sup>2/</sup>

Prior to the 2009 and 2010 notices, M&NJ had abandoned its 7.5-mile line between Slate Hill and Unionville, NY, by notice of exemption in AB-762X, Middletown and New Jersey Railway Company, Inc.-Abandonment Exemption-In Orange County, NY, 72 Fed. Reg. 29176 (May 20, 2008),<sup>3/</sup> effective June 19, 2008, consummation advice/notice filed Dec. 5, 2008.

The notices filed in F.D. Nos. 35227 and 35228 clearly indicate, in their color-coded maps, that the current M&NJ line extends only between Slate Hill and Middletown, NY.

This petition to reject or to revoke is addressed to the above-captioned notice of exemption, filed August 31, 2010, by M&NJ, pursuant to the carrier line acquisition class exemption, 49 CFR 1150.41, et seq.<sup>4/</sup> M&NJ seeks to lease<sup>5/</sup> from Norfolk

Southern Railway Company (NSR) portions of (1) Hudson Secondary, (2) Walden Secondary, (3) Maybrook Industrial Track, (4) Greycourt Industrial Track, and (5) EL Connection Track. In addition, M&NJ is acquiring from NSR (1) incidental overhead trackage rights over 4.36-mile main line, and (2) NSR's lease, by sublease, of apx. .35-mile of New York, Susquehanna & Western Railway (NYS&W) trackage at Hudson Jct., and (3) partial assignment of all NSR's trackage rights under the NYS&W trackage rights over the Hudson Secondary between Hudson Jct. and Warwick, NY. (Notice, 4-5).

Attached hereto as Appendix 1 is the Verified Statement of Samuel J. Nasca, with Exhibit A, being the color-coded map taken from the Notice indicating the lines to be acquired by lease or trackage rights.

#### Current Operations

Petitioner is unable to confirm the existence or extent of M&NJ's present operations. The listing of M&NJ in the current Official Railroad Station List, OP SL 6000-AE, issued January 1, 2010, with supplements through No. 6, effective April 15, 2010,<sup>6/</sup> indicate that the carrier is Middletown & New Jersey Railway Company, Inc., serving its stations between Middletown and Unionville, NY. Attached hereto as Appendix 2, are 9 pages from the current OP SL 6000-AE.

The current (2010-3Q) issue of The Official Railway Guide, (ORG) indicates that Middletown and New Jersey Railway Company, Inc. has a line between Agway Sta. and Middletown, with a connection with NSR at Middletown. The carrier is shown as "A Chartwell International, Inc. Company." Attached hereto as Appendix 3 are 4 pages from the current ORG. Petitioner is advised Chartwell International, Inc. currently is in bankruptcy.<sup>7/</sup>

#### Scope of the Transaction

The transaction noticed goes far beyond the scope of the usual §10902 carrier acquisition and operation class exemption. M&NJ on September 16, 2010 filed five agreements, in addition to the basic lease agreement previously submitted with its notice on August 31, 2010. 49 CFR 1150.43(h). The five additional agreements are termed (1) "Sublease Agreement," (2) "Partial Assignment of Trackage Rights Agreement and Supplemental Agreement," (3) "Thoroughbred Through Freight Agreement," (4) "Interchange Agreement," and (5) "Trackage Rights Agreement." Although all of the agreements are between M&NJ and NSR, Nos. 1 & 2 are also acknowledged and consented to by NYS&W. Moreover, the lines of a fourth carrier, Metro North Commuter Railroad Company, are involved, as indicated in the basic "Lease Agreement," filed August 31, 2010, under seal, with the notice of exemption, and on the map filed with the notice of exemption.

## ARGUMENT

I. THE NOTICE SHOULD BE REJECTED. The August 31, 2010 notice should be rejected. Simply stated, the transaction is more than a mere lease with incidental trackage rights. It is clear that a trackage rights agreement, in itself, is not embraced within the §10902 class exemption.

Moreover, the STB's regulations mention and embrace only three carriers. Here, at least four carriers are involved. This is too many, particularly since one of the carriers, Metro North, is a passenger carrier. The transaction is beyond the scope of the class exemption. 49 CFR 1150.41, 49 CFR 1150.42.

The Board should reject the notice as overly broad.

II. THE EXEMPTION SHOULD BE REVOKED. If the notice is not rejected, the exemption should be revoked. The applicable statute is premised upon the "public convenience and necessity."

§10902(c):

The Board shall issue a certificate authorizing activities for which authority is requested in an application filed under subsection (b) unless the Board finds that such activities are inconsistent with the public convenience and necessity.....

The elements of the rail transportation policy (RTP) to *be* considered in this petition to revoke are thus very extensive. Village of Palestine v. ICC, 936 F.2d 1135 (D.C. Cir. 1991), cert. den. 502 U.S. 1030.

The exemption should be revoked, 49 U.S.C. 10502(d), and the provisions of §10902 made applicable under the following criteria:

(a) Competition. The provisions of §10101(1), (4), (5), are directed to competition. We call attention to the dissent of Vice Chairman Mulvey, expressed in the STB's September 16, 2010 decision and order in this proceeding, which was directed to competition in connection with the interchange agreement between M&NJ and NSR. As indicated by the dissent, this is a strong ground for revocation of the exemption, and remitting M&NJ to an individual exemption petition or application is most appropriate.

(b) Honest and Efficient Management. The provisions of §10101(9) are directed to honest and efficient management of railroads. Here, M&NJ's action in apparently not being concerned with the proper listing of itself and its services in the predominant rail industry publications, Official Railroad Station List, and The Official Railway Guide, give the impression that M&NJ is merely a "paper" carrier, if it exists at all, apart from its mid-2009 notice in F.D. No. 35227. The OPSL listing is of critical importance as advice and holding out to the shipping public, but the ORG is also significant. The M&NJ line was abandoned south of Slate Hill in 2008, yet the listing and holding out to the public remain. The STB should require "fitness" testimony from M&NJ, proving any ability to provide honest and efficient management. UTU-NY makes this point in all seriousness.

(c) Safety. Although the STB is not the principal federal agency dealing with railroad safety, it is a factor in the RTP, §10101(8), (11), and is to be considered by the agency. Here, M&NJ will be performing operations on passenger trackage. This warrants requiring M&NJ to furnish evidence of a sound safety program prior to consummation of the transaction.

(d) Fair Wages and Working Conditions. The Verified Statement of Samuel J. Nasca illustrates the job loss anticipated if the transaction is consummated. Although the Board does not have authority to impose labor protective conditions in this situation, the interests of employees are to be considered under the "public convenience and necessity," and employee interest in fair wages and suitable working conditions are recognized under the RTP, §10101(11). Cf: I.C.C. v. Railway Labor Assn., 315 U.S. 373 (1942); Great Northern Ry. Co. Discontinuance of Service, 307 I.C.C. 59, 74 (1959).

CONCLUSION

The STB should reject the Notice of Exemption, filed August 31, 2010; if the notice is not rejected, the exemption should be revoked.

VERIFIED STATEMENT  
OF SAMUEL J. NASCA

My name is Samuel J. Nasca, with offices at 35 Fuller Road Albany, NY 12205. I serve as New York State Legislative Director for United Transportation Union (UTU-NY), a full-time elective position I have held since March 1984. My seniority commenced in 1967 on the former Erie-Lackawanna Railroad Company.

I am fully familiar with railroad operations in New York State, and with the lines involved in this exemption proceeding. I have read the notice of exemption, and the notice and decisions of the Surface Transportation Board (STB) in this proceeding.

The United Transportation Union (UTU) represents persons employed by Norfolk Southern Railway Company (NS), that perform work as engineers, conductors, brakemen, and switchmen.

Middletown & New Jersey Railroad, LLC (M&NJ) heretofore has been a small rail carrier based at Middletown, NY, and connecting with NS at that point. My understanding of the M&NJ notice of exemption, filed August 31, 2010, is that M&NJ will "lease" the so-called NS Campbell Hall cluster of lines, namely, portions of the Hudson Secondary, Walden Secondary, Maybrook Industrial Track, Greycourt Industrial Track, and the EL Connection Track. NS is also granting M&NJ overhead trackage over an undisclosed 4.36-mile portion of the NS main line; M&NJ acquiring operations over the New York, Susquehanna & Western Railroad (NYS&W) connecting at

Hudson Jct., and M&NJ operations over the Hudson Secondary between Hudson Jct. and Warwick. The color-coded map attached to the notice of exemption indicates the substantial scope of the track age involved in the transaction, also embracing operations over the NS (Metro North) Southern Tier. I have attached Exhibit A to the M&NJ notice of exemption, for ready reference.

As indicated in Exhibit A, and according to my understanding, the transaction includes M&NJ operations in conjunction with lines over which Metro North conducts passenger train service. I believe this may go beyond the customary "incidental trackage rights" associated with short line carrier acquisitions. In any event, in my opinion, the involvement of Metro North in itself should take the transaction out of the class exemption, and processed under an individual exemption petition or application.

My investigation indicates that some 15 NS employee positions would be lost if the notice of exemption becomes effective and the transaction is consummated. Moreover, in the event the exemption is subsequently revoked, and the positions restored, the involved individuals would not be compensated for the wages and benefits lost during the interim period. First, by the working of the seniority system, when positions are restored, the same individuals do not always secure the same jobs previously held. Second, the collective-bargaining agreements usually do not provide for claims involving loss of employment due to federal regulatory action. Third, the provisions of §10902 expressly provides labor conditions may not be imposed. Accordingly, the injury which would be sustained if the notice of exemption becomes operative, would be clearly irreparable, not only for the 15 individuals directly


involved, but also for many others who would be adversely affected by the "bumping" process associated with the exercise of seniority by the 15 directly involved.

I ask that the Board stay the operation of the notice of exemption, pending disposition of the UTU-NY forthcoming petition to revoke.






