Recently, TWU Local 225 and GL Bus Lines Inc. a subsidiary of Coach USA and the employer of members of the TWU Local 225 executed an amendment to their Collective Bargaining Agreement. The amendment added a successors clause insuring that the Collective Bargaining Agreement will survive changes in corporate control of the New York City Gray Line operation envisioned if the Surface Transportation Board approves the application before it.

Meanwhile, based on discussions and assurances with Twin America, TWU Local 225 is satisfied that work will not be transferred away from the bargaining unit, and that TWU Local 225 members will be protected from any potentially concerning aspects of the Twin America transaction.

Therefore, TWU Local 225 withdraws its objections to the approval of the Acquisition of Control application pending before the Surface Transportation Board.


