**Re: Docket No. AB-55 (Sub-No. 699X), CSX Transportation, Inc. —
Abandonment Exemption—in McMinn County, Tennessee**

Dear Ms. Brown:

Reference is made to the letter, dated April 27, 2010 (and received by the Board on May 5, 2010), from Mr. Anthony Casteel on behalf of the City of Athens, Tennessee (the "City") to the Board, requesting a 180-day extension of the NITU negotiating deadline (the "Extension Request") with respect to the line in the above-captioned proceeding.¹

CSX Transportation, Inc. ("CSXT") hereby acknowledges and concurs with the Extension Request, as it has not consummated the abandonment, has been unable to finalize negotiations with the City, and desires to continue to negotiate for interim trail use/rail banking with the City.

Accordingly, CSXT respectfully requests the Board grant the City's request for a 180-day extension of time to November 5, 2010 to negotiate trail use with the City. Additionally, CSXT respectfully requests an extension of the date to consummate the abandonment to January 4, 2011.
