This refers to Docket No. FD 35410, Adrian & Blissfield Rail Road Company—Continuance in Control Exemption—Jackson & Lansing Railroad Company, and Docket No. FD 35411, Jackson & Lansing Railroad Company—Lease and Operation Exemption—Norfolk Southern Railway Company, and to the Comments of Yreka Western Railroad Company filed February 10, 2011.

Yreka Western Railroad Company ("YW") requests leave to withdraw its Comments.

The filing on February 15, 2011, in Docket No. FD 35253, Arthur W. Single II, et al.—Continuance in Control Exemption—Charlotte Southern Railroad Company, et al., has the effect of correcting the false and misleading information in the September 20, 2011, filing by Adrian & Blissfield Rail Road Company ("ADBF") to which YW had sought to invite the Board's attention in asking that the ADBF's notice of exemption be declared null and void *ab initio*.

Moreover, significant progress has been made in the negotiations between YW and Jackson & Lansing Railroad Company ("JAIL") to resolve the blocked interchange tracks and congested yards which had prompted YW to call for the revocation of the exemption pursuant to which JAIL had leased certain lines from the Norfolk Southern Railway Company.

YW reserves the right to file a complaint against JAIL if its optimism that the problems it had encountered at JAIL's interchange tracks and yards shortly will be resolved should prove to have been unwarranted and YW were again to experience the inadequate power equipment and insufficient crews to move cars in and out of their storage sites.
