

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that Consolidated Rail Corporation ("Conrail") intends, on or after October 20, 1987, to file a Notice of Exemption with the Interstate Commerce Commission, pursuant to the exemption procedure set forth in 49 C.F.R. 1152, Subpart F, permitting Conrail to abandon the line of railroad described below:
