

LOAN AND SECURITY AGREEMENT TERMINATION

This Loan and Security Agreement Termination dated as of June 1, 2015 is between Minnesota Life Insurance Company, (formerly known as The Minnesota Mutual Life Insurance Company), as "Lender", and Manufacturers and Traders Trust Company, successor to The First National Bank of Maryland, as "Borrower."

WHEREAS, Lender and Borrower entered into that certain Loan and Security Agreement dated as of December 15, 1994 which was recorded at the Interstate Commerce Commission (the "Commission") on December 30, 1994 under Recordation No. 19147-A for all equipment leased under the lease and further recorded at the Registrar General of Canada on January 4, 1995 under Document Key No. 7177 (collectively, the "Loan Agreement and Recordation"), as supplemented by that certain Loan and Security Agreement Supplement No. 2 dated as of May 31, 1995 recorded at the Commission on May 31, 1995 under Recordation No. 19147-D for 105 tank cars numbered MBLX 34055, 34074, 34078, 34080, and 34090-34095, inclusive and 34098-34192 (except for 34132) inclusive and further recorded at the Registrar of Canada on June 5, 1995 under Document Key No. 7175 (collectively, the "Loan Supplement and Recordation" together with the Loan and Agreement and Recordation referred to as the "Lien Documents"). A list of all Equipment referenced in the Lien Documents is attached as Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, the rights and interests of Lender and the obligations of Borrower under the Lien Documents have been fulfilled with respect to the Loan and Security Agreement as amended; and

WHEREAS, Lender and Borrower have agreed to terminate the Lien Documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises:

Lender and Borrower hereby acknowledge and confirm for the public record the termination of the Lien Documents, and all their respective rights and obligations arising under the Lien Documents with respect to the equipment.

This Loan and Security Agreement Termination may be executed in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original for all purposes, but all such counterparts shall constitute but one and the same instrument.




