The parties to this Memorandum hereby acknowledge and confirm the following:

A. Greenbrier, as lessor, has leased certain railroad cars more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto (the "**Cars**") pursuant to that certain Lease Agreement dated as of April 15, 2014, and Schedule No. 1 thereto (Schedule No. 1, and the Lease Agreement as it pertains to Schedule No. 1, each as amended, modified, extended, supplemented, restated and/or replaced from time to time, the "**Lease**") to Schlumberger Technology Corporation.
