ASSIGNMENT OF SECURITY AGREEMENT AND OF NOTE AGREEMENT

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, the undersigned, Ohio State University, with its office and place of business at 190 North Oval Drive, Columbus, Ohio, hereby (i) sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to Indianapolis Life Insurance Company, with its office and principal place of business at 2960 North Meridian Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, all right title and interest of said Ohio State University, as Secured Party in, under and to that certain Security Agreement dated as of April 15, 1970 from United States Leasing International, Inc., as Debtor, to Ohio State University, as Secured Party, covering 15 coal hopper cars more particularly described in Schedule 1 to the Security Agreement, and (ii) further assigns to Indianapolis Life Insurance Company all its rights, privileges and interest under that certain Note Agreement dated as of April 15, 1970 between United States Leasing International, Inc. and Ohio State University dated as of April 15, 1970 relating to the financing of said railway cars.

Said Security Agreement was executed and delivered as security for the 9-1/2% Secured Note of the Debtor dated June 25, 1970 payable to the order of Ohio State University in the principal sum of \$294,837.00, and which Security Agreement was filed for record on June 25, 1970 at 10:25 A.M., in the office of the Interstate Commerce Commission and received Recordation No. 5763.

Ohio State University does hereby irrevocably appoint and constitute Indianapolis Life Insurance Company its true and lawful attorney with full power of substitution to do everything whatsoever requisite or necessary to be done in the premises as fully as Ohio State University might or could do if this Assignment had not been made, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said attorney or substitute shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Ohio State University has caused its corporate name to be hereunto subscribed by its Vice President, its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested by its Secretary, all as of the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1970.
