

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that

WHEREAS, Union Pacific Railroad Company, a Utah corporation (the "Company"), and General Motors Corporation (Electro-Motive Division), a New York corporation, Gunderson, Inc., an Oregon corporation, International Car Company, an Illinois corporation, Pacific Car and Foundry Company, a Washington corporation, Union Pacific Motor Freight Company, a Nebraska corporation, and The Darby Products of Steel Plate Corporation, a Kansas corporation (collectively, the "Manufacturers") entered into a Conditional Sale Agreement, dated as of May 1, 1971 (the "Conditional Sale Agreement"), covering the construction, sale and delivery and purchase of 901 units of new railroad equipment (the "Equipment") described in Schedule A thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Conditional Sale Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission (the "Commission") under Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act (the "Act") on August 16, 1971, and assigned Recordation Nos. 6171A and 6282; and

WHEREAS, the Manufacturers entered into an Agreement and Assignment, dated as of May 1, 1971 (the "Assignment"), with The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association), a national banking association (the "Agent"), covering the assignment and transfer by the Manufacturers to the Agent of their right, title and interest in and to the Equipment and the Conditional Sale Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Company and the Agent entered into a First Supplemental Agreement, dated August 6, 1976 (the "First Supplemental Agreement"), which amended the Conditional Sale Agreement to provide for the substitution of certain railroad equipment for certain units of the Equipment (the 899 units subject to the Conditional Sale Agreement following such amendment are described in the attached Schedule A and are hereinafter referred to as the "Units"); and

WHEREAS, the First Supplemental Agreement was filed and recorded with the Commission under Section 20c of the Act on August 6, 1976, and assigned Recordation No. 6171-B; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 1977, the Company paid the final installment due under the Conditional Sale Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Company has paid the Agent the full aggregate purchase price for all of the Units, together with

interest, and any and all other payments as provided in the Conditional Sale Agreement and the Company does hereby represent and warrant that it has performed all the covenants and conditions contained in the Conditional Sale Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned, The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association), does hereby declare and acknowledge that, to the best of its knowledge and belief and based on the foregoing, all the terms and conditions stipulated in the Conditional Sale Agreement have been fully performed and that all the purchase money stipulated in, and other monies payable under, the Conditional Sale Agreement have been fully paid, released and discharged.

WHEREUPON, The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association) does hereby, by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Company the aforesaid Units free and clear of all liens and encumbrances created in or retained by it under the Conditional Sale Agreement or the Assignment, or either of them, it being understood that The Chase Manhattan Bank (National Association) makes no other representations and warranties, expressed or implied, with respect to any other liens or with respect to any other matters relating to the Units.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Units

unto the Company, its successors and assigns forever.


