SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT DATED AS OF AUGUST 21, 1970  
TO EQUIPMENT TRUST AGREEMENT DATED AS OF FEBRUARY 15, 1970

BY AND BETWEEN

CHEMICAL BANK, TRUSTEE

AND

GENERAL AMERICAN TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION

Supplemental Agreement dated as of August 21, 1970, between Chemical Bank, a New York corporation, as Trustee, and General American Transportation Corporation, a New York corporation.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into an Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of February 15, 1970 (the "Agreement") creating General American Transportation Corporation Equipment Trust, Series 66, which Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on February 12, 1970, Recordation No. 5581; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto wish to amend Schedule A to the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree that Schedule A to the Agreement is hereby amended by:

(a) deleting therefrom eleven (11) Tank Cars of Class DOT 112A340-W, each having a capacity of 33,500 gallons, initialed GATX and numbered 23900 to 23910, both inclusive, and

(b) substituting therefor the following eleven (11) Tank Cars:




