

ration Equipment Trust, Series 66, which Agreement was filed and  
recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to  
Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on February 12, 1970  
Recordation No. 5581; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto entered into a Supplemental  
Agreement dated as of August 21, 1970 and December 18, 1970  
amending Schedule A to the Agreement by deleting therefrom specified  
Units of Equipment and substituting therefor other specified Units  
of Equipment, which Supplemental Agreement filed and recorded  
with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of  
the Interstate Commerce Act on August 31, 1970 and January 4, 1971,  
Recordation Numbers 5581-A and 5581-B respectively;

WHEREAS, the parties hereto wish to further amend  
Schedule A to the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree that Schedule A to  
the Agreement is hereby amended by:

(a) deleting therefrom the Units of Equipment described  
in Schedule I hereto, and

(b) substituting therefor the Units of Equipment de-  
scribed in Schedule II hereto.




