INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION
THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT dated as of December 22, 1970,
between PULLMAN INCORPORATED (Pullman-Standard Division) (hereinafter call-
ed the "Lessor") and TRAILER TRAIN COMPANY (hereinafter called the "Lessee");

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Lessor and Lessee have entered into a Railroad Equip-
ment Lease dated as of June 15, 1970, (hereinafter called the "Lease"), which
Lease was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission under Section 20c
of the Interstate Commerce Act of June 18, 1970 at 12:20 P. M. and assigned
Recordation No. 5755; and

WHEREAS, the Lessor and Lessee have entered into Supplemental
Agreements dated as of July 10, 1970, August 21, 1970 and September 1, 1970,
which Supplemental Agreements were recorded with the Interstate Commerce
Commission under Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on July 16, 1970 at
1:50 P. M. and assigned Recordation No. 5755-A, August 27, 1970 at 1:50 P. M.
and assigned Recordation No. 5755-B and September 22, 1970 at 2:10 P. M. and
assigned Recordation No. 5755-C respectively; and

WHEREAS, Lessor and Lessee desire to supplement and amend the
Lease so as to extend the date for purchase as set forth in Section 3 of Schedule
of the Lease.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises,
covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth the parties hereto do hereby agree
as follows:

1. Section 3 of Schedule "A" to the Lease is hereby amended to
read as follows: "Date by Which Purchase of Cars Must Be Made:"
February 28, 1971

2. The Lease, as supplemented by the Agreement, shall continue
in full force and effect.

3. Lessee will, at its expense, upon execution and delivery of this agreement, cause the same to be duly filed and recorded with Interstate Commerce Commission in accordance with Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act, as amended, and wherever else required in order to publish notice of and to protect the title of Lessor to the Cars.


