

## AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT

### R E C I T A L S

Under Lease (the "Lease") dated October 6th, 1971, Pacific Car and Foundry Company, a Washington Corporation, leased to Burlington Northern Inc. ("Lessee"), a Delaware Corporation, one 200,000 pound nominal capacity bulk and standard loading steel sheathed, fiberglass interior refrigerator car, Pacific Car and Foundry Company specification PC194, bearing road number WFEX 6000 (the "Car"), for a term of one year commencing October 7th, 1971. The Lease has been recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20C of the Interstate Commerce Act on October 26, 1971, Recordation Number 6380.

Under Amendment recorded with the ICC on November 15, 1973 under Recordation Number 6380-B, the parties extended the term of the lease to October 7, 1974 and otherwise amended the lease as provided therein.

Pacific Car and Foundry Company subsequent to the date of the Lease has merged into PACCAR Inc, a Delaware corporation, and PACCAR Inc (herein "Lessor") has succeeded to all rights of Pacific Car and Foundry Company, as Lessor under the Lease.

Lessor and Lessee now desire to extend the term of the Lease further.

### A G R E E M E N T S

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, Lessor and Lessee agree as follows:

(1) the Lease is hereby extended to December 7, 1974, upon all terms and conditions of the Lease, as heretofore amended.

(2) Lessee confirms and warrants to Lessor the Car is currently in the condition and repair required by the Lease, and is in the possession of Lessee.

(3) The Lease, as amended, is hereby ratified and confirmed and remains in full force and effect.

(4) This amendment shall take effect upon recordation hereof with the Interstate Commerce Commission.


