

RELEASE AND DISCHARGE

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

This Release and Discharge dated December 22, 1976, from ACF INDUSTRIES, INCORPORATED (the "Secured Party") whose principal office is at 750 Third Avenue, New York, New York to FIRST SECURITY BANK OF UTAH, N.A., as Trustee (the "Debtor") under SSI Rail Trust No. 76-3, whose principal office is at 79 South Main Street, Salt Lake City, Utah,

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Debtor by an Interim Purchase Money Security Agreement (the "Security Agreement") granted a security interest to the Secured Party in certain railroad equipment (the "Collateral") more particularly described in Schedule A attached hereto as security for the payment of the purchase price of the Collateral; and

WHEREAS, the Security Agreement has been filed with and recorded by the Interstate Commerce Commission on November 18, 1976 at 1:45 P.M. pursuant to the provisions of Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act and has been assigned Recordation No. 8580; and

WHEREAS, the purchase price of the Collateral and all other sums secured by the Security Agreement have been paid in full;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and in pursuance of the terms and provisions of the Security Agreement, the Secured Party hereby releases and relinquishes any and all right, title, claim or demand of the Secured Party in and to the Collateral arising by, through or under the Security Agreement and further authorizes this Release and Discharge to be filed with and recorded by the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act in order to discharge the Security Agreement and to satisfy the same of record.
