This Amendment to the Equipment Trust Agreement, Series 7, dated as of February 1, 1975 (the "Agreement"), by and between RICHMOND LEASING COMPANY (the "Company") and THE FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF FORT WORTH, as Trustee ("Trustee") shall be effective as of February 1, 1975.

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the parties to the Agreement are desirous of amending the Agreement to bring about changes and to correct certain obvious inconsistencies and typographical errors contained therein, all in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and conditions contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

(a) At the following locations in the Agreement, "10%" is deleted and "11.95%" is substituted therefor;

(i) in lines 11 and 15 from the bottom of page 25;

(ii) in lines 17 and 20 of Section 6.03 on page 28;

(iii) in line 4 from the top of page 29;

(iv) in the last line of page 32; and

(v) in line 5 from the top of page 33.

(b) On page 23, the wording beginning with " . . . provided, however, . . . " on line 11 and extending through " . . . pursuant hereto, . . . " on line 14 thereof is hereby deleted.






