MANUFACTURING AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENT NO. 2

dated as of September 5, 1978 between Pullman Incorporated (Pullman Standard Division) (hereinafter called the Manufacturer) and Trailer Train Company (hereinafter called the Company).

The parties hereto have heretofore entered into a Manufacturing Agreement dated as of May 15, 1978, which was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on May 18, 1978, at 1:20 PM recordation number 9390, which provides for the execution and delivery from time to time of supplements thereto each substantially in the form hereof for the purpose of subjecting to said Manufacturing Agreement additional units of new, standard gauge railroad equipment.

The units of railroad equipment described in Item 1 of Annex A hereto are hereby subjected to said Manufacturing Agreement. 
