
WHEREAS, pursuant to a Chattel Mortgage and Security Agreement dated May 26, 1978 between ATLANTIC & WESTERN FINANCIAL CORPORATION ("A&W") whose address is P.O.Box 1208 Sanford, North Carolina 27330, and MARINE MIDLAND BANK, a New York banking corporation, ("Marine") which Chattel Mortgage and Security Agreement was filed with with the Interstate Commerce Commission on June 1, 1978 under Recordation Number 9414, A&W granted to Marine a security interest in an a lien upon fifty (50) fifty foot general or special purpose boxcars Class "XM" or "XF", numbered as follows: twenty-five (25) general purpose class "XM" boxcars bearing Atlantic & Western Corporation numbers ATW 16000 through ATW 16024 inclusive and twenty five (25) boxcars bearing Hutchinson and Northern Railway Company, numbers HN 2000 to HN 2024 inclusive, and

WHEREAS, Marine has received repayment in full of the indebtedness due Marine from A&W, it is




