

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION
Amendment Agreement dated as of June 15,

1979, among First Security State Bank, acting as Trustee (the "Vendee"), under a Trust Agreement dated as of April 1, 1978, with BWL Leasing Corporation (the "Owner Participant"), Seaboard Coast Line Railroad Company (the "Lessee") and First Security Bank of Utah, N.A. (the "Agent").

WHEREAS the Vendee and the Lessee have entered into a Lease of Railroad Equipment dated as of April 1, 1978 (the "Lease");

WHEREAS the Agent and the Vendee have entered into an Assignment of Lease and Agreement dated as of April 1, 1978 (the "Lease Assignment");

WHEREAS the Lease and the Lease Assignment were filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on June 2, 1978, and were assigned recordation number 9420; and

WHEREAS the parties hereto now desire to amend the Lease to increase the rental payment amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Lease is hereby amended by deleting the

rental payment factor of 6.8725% which appears in the first paragraph of Section 2 of the Lease and substituting therefor the rental payment factor of 7.0379%.

2. The Lease Assignment is hereby amended to permit the aforesaid amendment to the Lease as though originally set forth therein.

3. The Lessee will promptly cause this Amendment Agreement to be filed and recorded in accordance with the provisions of Section 14 of the Lease.

4. Except as amended hereby the Lease and the Lease Assignment shall remain unaltered and in full force and effect.

5. This Amendment Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, and such counterparts together shall constitute a single instrument. It shall not be necessary that any counterpart be signed by all the parties if each party shall sign at least one counterpart.
