

RELEASE OF MORTGAGE ON TANK CARS

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT WHEREAS, under date of the 29th day of May, 1975, SAUVAGE GAS COMPANY, to secure the payment of the indebtedness evidenced by its promissory note of said date for the principal sum of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$450,000.00), payable to BANK OF OKLAHOMA, N.A. (formerly named National Bank of Tulsa), or order, in monthly installments and bearing interest as therein provided, made, executed and delivered to BANK OF OKLAHOMA, N.A., with principal office and post office address at Bank of Oklahoma Tower, Tulsa, Oklahoma, its certain Mortgage on Tank Cars, covering the hereinafter described property:

Fifteen (15) 100-Ton, 33,600 gallon, ICC class 112-A-400W Tank Cars, numbered SAUX 734 through 746, inclusive
