INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT, effective May 18, 1976, this Rider shall become a part of Master Car Agreement No. 10572 between TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION OF AMERICA and Plum Creek Lumber Company dated June 16, 1972 and the cars described herein shall be placed in Plum Creek Lumber Company service, subject to the terms set forth below:

\$440.00 per car per month for 120
months from delivery date subject to
escalation for increases in maintenance
costs, beginning at the 13th month
following delivery, and in monthly
rental for increase in cost of car
prior to date of manufacture as
defined below. Lessee has option of
renewing lease for additional 60 months
at same rate.

ESCALATION OF LEASE BASED
ON INCREASES IN COST OF
EQUIPMENT PRIOR TO
DELIVERY DATE:

The monthly lease rate is subject to
escalation based on increase in the
cost of a car as follows: The monthly
rental per car will increase \$5.00 for
each \$500.00 or proportion thereof
increase in the cost of the car during
the period prior to the date that we
would begin manufacture of the car.

ESCALATION OF
MAINTENANCE:

Commencing with the 13th month, main-
tenance will be escalated in direct
proportion to the published AAR
Interchange rate. Our rental rate
will increase \$1.01 per car, per month,
for each one per cent (1%) or fraction
thereof increase of the AAR rate over
the \$17.27 per hour rate in effect
at May 1, 1976.

FRA INSPECTION:

Any inspection charges resultant from
FRA requirements are not covered by this
lease and are for the account of the
LESSEE.


