Our rental rate will increase \$1.01 per car, per month, for each one per cent (1%) or fraction thereof increase of the AAR rate over the \$25.47 per hour rate in effect at January 1, 1978.

FRA INSPECTION: Any inspection charges resultant from FRA requirements are not covered by this lease and are for the account of the LESSEE.
