Dear Sirs:

Reference is made to the Equipment Lease between us dated as of July 1, 1975 respecting 154 hopper cars and 110 tank cars. Paragraph 24(a) of said Lease is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the first sentence and substituting the following:

"As soon as practicable on or after the expiration of the term of this Lease in the event all or any portion of the Equipment has not been purchased pursuant to the provisions of this Lease, Lessee will, at its sole cost and expense, at the request of Lessor, deliver such Equipment to Lessor upon such storage tracks as Lessor may reasonably designate, and store the same on such tracks for a period not exceeding 60 days."
