

AMENDMENT TO  
STORAGE AGREEMENT DATED AS OF MAY 16, 1979

AUG 31 1979 - 12 35 PM

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

THIS AGREEMENT made this 28th day of August, 1979, by and between PULLMAN INCORPORATED (Pullman Standard Division), (hereinafter called the "Manufacturer"), and ILLINOIS CENTRAL GULF RAILROAD COMPANY, (hereinafter called the "Railroad")

## W I T N E S S E T H :

The Manufacturer and the Railroad heretofore entered into a Storage Agreement dated as of May 16, 1979 and amended May 30, 1979, (herein the "Storage Agreement"), providing for the temporary custody and care by the Railroad, as a bailee, pending the arrangement of permanent financing, of the following railroad equipment, (hereinafter called the "Cars") which are being purchased from the Manufacturer:

250 -100-ton Covered Hopper Cars,  
4750 Cubic Foot Capacity,  
numbered ICG 767093-767199,  
inclusive

The parties to the Storage Agreement desire to amend said Storage Agreement in certain respects. Accordingly, the parties hereby agree that the termination date under the Storage Agreement for 107 cars numbered ICG 767093-767199, inclusive, shall be amended to such date when the Railroad's financing arrangements have been concluded and payment of the purchase price has been rendered to the Manufacturer provided that such termination date shall be no later than **October 31, 1979.**

Except as expressly amended hereby, the Storage Agreement shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with the provisions thereof.
