KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Union Tank Car Company, a Delaware corporation (herein the "Company"), has sold, assigned, transferred, set over and delivered, and by these presents does hereby sell, assign, transfer, set over and deliver, unto The First National Bank of Chicago, as Trustee under that certain Equipment Trust Agreement dated as of September 15, 1972 (the "Trust Agreement"), between the Company and said The First National Bank of Chicago, 66 railroad cars (herein the "cars"), each identified with the initials UTLX (unless otherwise indicated), and more fully described in Schedule A attached hereto and hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

The Company hereby warrants title to the cars is free from all liens and encumbrances (including any leasehold interest therein) other than the rights of the Company under the Trust Agreement.
