

RELEASE OF MORTGAGE OF
RAILROAD ROLLING STOCK

THE CITY NATIONAL BANK & TRUST COMPANY OF COLUMBUS ("Mortgagee"), concerning the Mortgage identified herein to which Mortgagor and SOUTH-EAST COAL COMPANY and SOUTH-EAST COAL SALES COMPANY (collectively, "Mortgagor") are parties, hereby Recites and Agrees as follows:

Recitals

1. On December 23, 1975, Mortgagor and Mortgagee executed a Mortgage of Railroad Rolling Stock ("the Mortgage") which was recorded in compliance with the provisions of the Interstate Commerce Act, 49 U.S.C. § 20(c) [§ 11303(a)] on January 1, 1976, at 4:10 P.M. and assigned recordation number 8194. 




