INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

AMENDMENT AGREEMENT, dated as of May 1, 1976, among PULLMAN INCORPORATED (Pullman Standard Division) (hereinafter called the Builder), UNITED STATES TRUST COMPANY OF NEW YORK (hereinafter called the Owner-Trustee), as Trustee under a Trust Agreement dated as of March 1, 1976 with General Electric Credit Corporation, UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY (hereinafter called the Guarantor), and MERCANTILE-SAFE DEPOSIT AND TRUST COMPANY, as agent (hereinafter called the Vendor).

WHEREAS the Builder, the Owner-Trustee and the Guarantor have entered into a Conditional Sale Agreement dated as of March 1, 1976 (hereinafter called the Conditional Sale Agreement);

WHEREAS the Conditional Sale Agreement was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on March 30, 1976, at 4:35 p.m., and was assigned recordation number 8251;

WHEREAS the Conditional Sale Agreement has been assigned by the Builder to the Vendor pursuant to an Agreement and Assignment dated as of March 1, 1976 (hereinafter called the Assignment);

WHEREAS the Assignment was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on March 30, 1976, at 4:35 p.m., and was assigned recordation number 8251-A; and

WHEREAS the parties hereto now desire to amend the Conditional Sale Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

1. Annex B to the Conditional Sale Agreement is hereby amended to add thereto nine (9) 50' 6" 70-ton capacity general service box cars numbered 21351 through 21359.
2. Except as hereby amended, the Conditional Sale Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
3. The Assignment is hereby amended to permit the aforesaid amendment to the Conditional Sale Agreement as though originally set forth therein.
4. The Owner-Trustee will promptly cause this Amendment Agreement to be filed and recorded in accordance with the provisions of Article 19 of the Conditional Sale Agreement.
5. This Amendment Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, such counterparts together consti-

tuting but one and the same instrument.


