

STATEMENT OF NEW NUMBER

This supplemental agreement and statement of new number is made this 12th day of September, 1978, by and between Joseph H. and Mary T. Battin, hereinafter referred to as "Debtor," and The National Bank of Washington, hereinafter referred to as "Secured Party."

WHEREAS, Debtor and Secured Party executed one certain ~~Security Agreement dated December 23, 1976~~ conveying a security interest in one (1) seventy ton, fifty foot, six inch rigid underframe boxcar(s), known as XF cars, bearing serial number(s): #VC 9170; and

WHEREAS said serial number(s) have been or may in the future be changed.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar plus other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by Debtor, the Debtor hereby agrees, represents and warrants as follows:

1. Change of Serial Number: Debtor warrants and represents to Secured Party that the XF car(s) pledged as collateral in paragraph three of the aforesaid Security Agreement bear(s) the following new serial number(s):

2. Notification: Debtor shall notify Secured Party of any future change in serial number(s) of the car(s) pledged as collateral in paragraph 3 of the aforesaid Security Agreement, within ten (10) days of any such change. Failure to so notify Secured Party shall constitute a default under the aforesaid Security Agreement.

3. Ratification: It is further understood and agreed that all other terms, conditions and covenants of the aforesaid Security Agreement, not otherwise modified hereby, shall be and remain the same and are hereby ratified, and that this Statement of New Number, when executed by the parties hereto, shall be attached to and become part of the aforesaid Security Agreement, and shall have the same force and effect as if the terms and conditions hereof were originally incorporated in such Security Agreement, prior to its execution.
