

SUPPLEMENT TO SECURITY AGREEMENT INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

THIS SUPPLEMENT dated as of August 28, 1978, to the Security Agreement (hereinafter the "Security Agreement") dated as of July 26, 1978, by and between TEXAS COMMERCE BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, a national banking association (hereinafter called "Secured Party"), and DOUGLASS EQUIPMENT LEASING COMPANY, a general partnership organized and existing under the laws of the State of Texas (hereinafter called the "Debtor"):

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, Section II of the Security Agreement includes as Equipment subject to the provisions of the Security Agreement the railroad tank cars described therein;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Security Agreement the Debtor has granted to the Secured Party a security interest in the Equipment listed in said Section II;

WHEREAS, the parties desire to supplement the Security Agreement as provided herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The Security Agreement is hereby supplemented to identify by Registration Number eight railroad tank cars included in the Equipment as described in Section II of the Security Agreement, such cars bearing the following Registration Numbers: RTMX 12376, 12377, 12378, 12379, 12380 and 12381. Such cars, as Equipment, are subject to all the terms and conditions of the Security Agreement as applicable to Equipment, including the security interest created under Section I thereof.

2. The Security Agreement, as hereby supplemented, remains in full force and effect mutatis mutandis.

3. The Security Agreement, as hereby supplemented, is in all respects ratified and confirmed, and

all rights and powers created or granted thereby or thereunder shall be and remain in full force and effect.

4. Terms used in this Supplement have the same meaning herein as in the Security Agreement.

5. The terms "Security Agreement" and "Agreement" as used in the Security Agreement shall be construed to mean the Security Agreement as supplemented by this Supplement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have caused their names to be signed hereto by their respective officers and representatives thereunto duly authorized, effective as of the date first written above.
