CANCELLATION AGREEMENT

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

This Cancellation Agreement, made and entered into this 22nd day of August, 1973, by and between PULLMAN INCORPORATED (PULLMAN-STANDARD DIVISION), a corporation, (hereinafter called "Builder"), ILLINOIS TERMINAL RAILROAD COMPANY, a corporation, (hereinafter called "Buyer"), and FIRST NATIONAL BANK IN ST. LOUIS, a national banking association, (hereinafter called "Assignee"),

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of \$1.00 and for other good and valuable mutual considerations, the parties hereto agree that:

1. Conditional Sale Agreement between Builder and Buyer dated as of July 1, 1973, covering the purchase of 200, 100 ton, covered hoppers to bear Buyer's car series numbers ITC 1800 to 1999, inclusive, at a total estimated cost of \$3,570,000, and Agreement and Assignment between Builder and Assignee dated as of July 1, 1973, whereby all rights, title and interest of Builder under said Conditional Sale Agreement was assigned to Assignee, and to which Agreement Buyer executed its consent, and which Agreements were duly recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission under the provisions of Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on July 20, 1973, at 11:20 A.M., bearing Recordation No. 7109, are hereby declared null and void and of no further force and effect as of the date first written
