

THAT IN CONSIDERATION of the payment in full according to the face and tenor thereof of a certain promissory note executed by WAYNE D. HARBIN in the original principal amount of \$180,000, dated the 21st day of July, 1977, described in a "Security Agreement - Railroad Tank Car" signed by Wayne D.
