

In consideration of \$3,301,353.00 and other valuable consideration, FMC Corporation, a Delaware corporation (the "Builder"), the Builder under a conditional sale agreement (the "Conditional Sale Agreement") with SSI Rail Corp., a Delaware corporation ("SSI"), recorded on 15 November 1977 with the Interstate Commerce Commission as recordation #9084, hereby releases and discharges SSI and Itel Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("Itel") from any and all liability or other obligation which either SSI or Itel may have under the Conditional Sale Agreement.
