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AMENDMENT AGREEMENT dated as of February 5, 1979, between ACF INDUSTRIES, INCORPORATED (hereinafter called the Manufacturer) and AMERICAN RAIL BOX CAR COMPANY (hereinafter called the Company).

WHEREAS, the Manufacturer and the Company have entered into a Manufacturing Agreement dated as of January 15, 1978, filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on January 30, 1978, recordation number 9219, and as supplemented as of January 8, 1979, recorded January 11, 1979, recordation number 9219-A; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend the Manufacturing Agreement:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements herein contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The Manufacturing Agreement is hereby amended to delete from Annex A thereto as supplemented, one hundred twenty six (126), 50'6" 70-ton capacity, general service boxcars numbered 32450 through 32575.

2. The Manufacturing Agreement, except as amended hereby, shall remain unaltered and in full force and effect.

3. The Company will promptly cause this Amendment Agreement to be filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission in accordance with the Interstate Commerce Act, 49 U.S.C. § 11303(a).
