MANUFACTURING AGREEMENT SUPPLEMENT INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

dated as of October 1, 1979, between THRALL CAR MANUFACTURING COMPANY (hereinafter called the Manufacturer) and TRAILER TRAIN COMPANY (hereinafter called the Company).

The parties hereto have heretofore entered into a Manufacturing Agreement dated as of April 10, 1978, which was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act (now 49 U.S.C. § 11,303(a)) on April 12, 1978, at 1:20 P.M., recordation number 9324, which provides for the execution and delivery from time to time of supplements thereto each substantially in the form hereof for the purpose of subjecting to said Manufacturing Agreement additional units of new, standard gauge railroad equipment.

The units of railroad equipment described in Item 1 of Annex A hereto are hereby subjected to said Manufacturing Agreement. The information set forth in Annex A hereto in respect of such units of railroad equipment, and set forth in Items 2, 3 and 4 of said Annex A, is hereby incorporated into Annex A to the Manufacturing Agreement as though originally set forth therein; provided, however, that such information shall apply and refer only to the units of railroad equipment described in Annex A hereto.

The Company will promptly cause this Supplement No. 1 to be filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to the requirements of 49 U.S.C. § 11,303(a).






