INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

This SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT, effective as of April 1, 1974, by and among SECURITY NATIONAL BANK, a national banking association incorporated and existing under the laws of the United States, as Trustee under the Trust Agreement as hereinafter defined (hereinafter called "Security"); and RICHMOND LEASING COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware (hereinafter called "RLC"):

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, Security and RLC as successor to Marathon Leasing Company, a Delaware corporation, have previously entered into Marathon Leasing Company Equipment Trust, Series Five, dated as of April 1, 1973, and filed with the Interstate Commerce Commission at 1:15 p.m. on May 1, 1973, under Recordation No. 7011 (hereinafter the "Trust Agreement"), pursuant to which Trust Agreement there were issued and sold Trust Certificates in the aggregate amount of \$3,000,000 (hereinafter the "Trust Certificates") which funds (the "Trust Funds") have constituted the Marathon Leasing Company Equipment Trust, Series Five (the "Equipment Trust, Series Five"); and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Trust Funds have been disbursed from time to time to finance 80% of the purchase price of the Trust Equipment (as defined in the Trust Agreement); and

WHEREAS, RLC is desirous of financing from the Trust Funds pursuant to the Trust Agreement certain additional railway equipment specified in Attachment A hereto (hereinafter the "Railway Equipment"), which Railway Equipment is subject

to the Lease specified in Attachment B hereto (the "Lease "); the Railway Equipment and the Lease not having been included in the Trust Agreement or in the Exhibits A or B thereto when the Trust Agreement was originally executed; and

WHEREAS, Security is agreeable to amend the Trust Agreement to include in Exhibit A the Railway Equipment and in Exhibit B the Lease .


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, Security and RLC hereby agree as follows:

The Trust Agreement is hereby amended to include in Exhibit A the Railway Equipment listed in Attachment A hereof, and to include in Exhibit B the Lease listed in Attachment B hereof. Accordingly, each time the term "Trust Equipment" is used in the Trust Agreement it shall mean and include the Railway Equipment, and each time the term "Existing Leases" is used in the Trust Agreement, it shall mean and include the Lease .

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Security and RLC have caused their names to be signed hereto by their respective officers thereunto duly authorized and their respective corporate seals, duly attested, to be hereunto affixed effective as of the date first written above.
