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

RELEASE AND SATISFACTION AND BILL OF SALE


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Mercantile Trust Company National Association (the "Bank"), assignee under an Agreement and Assignment dated as of June 15, 1972, between ACF Industries Incorporated (the "Manufacturer"), and the Bank under which the Bank was assigned certain rights of the Manufacturer in and to certain railroad equipment (the "Equipment") under a Conditional Sale Agreement dated as of June 15, 1972, (the "Conditional Sale Agreement"), between the Manufacturer and Illinois Terminal Railroad Company (the "Illinois Terminal"), covering the Equipment, hereby certifies that the full purchase price for the Equipment and the interest accrued from time to time on the unpaid principal of said purchase price, and other payments provided for in the Conditional Sale Agreement have been paid, and the obligations under the Conditional Sale Agreement have been complied with and performed to the full satisfaction of the Bank.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Bank hereby declares the ~~Conditional Sale Agreement to be satisfied and canceled~~, consents that the ~~Conditional Sale Agreement~~ be discharged of record, sells, assigns, transfers and releases to Norfolk and Western Railway Company ("NW") (successor to the rights and interests of the Illinois Terminal under the Conditional Sale Agreement pursuant to an Assignment and Assumption Agreement dated as of September 1, 1981) as its absolute property, all of the right, title and interest of the Bank in and to the Equipment, and releases NW and the Illinois Terminal from any and all obligations under the Conditional Sale Agreement.
