

This is an ASSIGNMENT, dated as of July 19, 1985, among CONTINENTAL ILLINOIS NATIONAL BANK AND TRUST COMPANY OF CHICAGO (in its capacity as agent called the "Existing Agent") and MANUFACTURERS HANOVER TRUST COMPANY (in its capacity as successor agent called the "Successor Agent").

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, Evans Railcar Leasing Company, an Illinois corporation ("Railcar"), and the Existing Agent are parties to an Amended and Restated Security Agreement dated as of May 20, 1983 (the "Old Security Agreement"), as amended and restated as of June 30, 1984, as from time to time amended, supplemented or modified (the "Security Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Old Security Agreement was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on June 17, 1983 under recordation no. 14059 and the Security Agreement was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on October 4, 1984 under recordation no. 14059-S; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain Agency Succession Agreement and Amendment of even date herewith, the Existing Agent has resigned and the Successor Agent has been appointed to succeed the Existing Agent as agent;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual agreements herein contained, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

(1) The Existing Agent hereby grants, conveys, assigns, transfers and sets over to the Successor Agent all of its right, title and interest in, to and under the Security Agreement.
