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



NOTICE OF RENUMBERING

INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

RECITALS:

1. Continental Illinois National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, as Vendor, and the Detroit, Toledo and Iron- ton Railroad Company ("DT&I"), as Vendee, entered into a conditional sale agreement ("CSA") dated as of November 15, 1979, for the conditional sale of four locomotives, which CSA was recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission on Nov- ember 15, 1979, and assigned recordation No. 11055.


2. Said locomotives are GP 40-2 diesel electric locomo- tives, numbered 422 through 425, both inclusive.
