WHEREAS, on or about the 23rd day of August, 1978, a Security Agreement (hereinafter called "Agreement") was entered into by and between MISSOURI-KANSAS-TEXAS RAILROAD COMPANY, a Delaware corporation, Debtor, having its principal place of business at 701 Commerce Street, Dallas, Texas 75202, and FROST NATIONAL BANK OF SAN ANTONIO, Secured Party, P.
