

DATED AS OF March 28, 1980, between PACCAR Inc,
(hereinafter called the Manufacturer) and RAILBOX
COMPANY (hereinafter called the Company).


The parties hereto have heretofore entered into a Manufacturing Agreement dated as of December 15, 1977, which was filed and recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission pursuant to Section 20c of the Interstate Commerce Act on December 27, 1977, at 9:30 a.m., recordation number 9134, which provides for the execution and delivery from time to time of supplements thereto each substantially in the form hereof for the purpose of subjecting to said Manufacturing Agreement additional units of new, standard gauge railroad equipment.
