

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That CHEMICAL BANK, as Trustee under a certain Equipment Trust Agreement, as supplemented, dated as of April 1, 1971, between Chemical Bank, Trustee, and The Texas And Pacific Railway Company, providing for the leasing of certain Trust Equipment to the Railroad Company, the Equipment Trust Agreement establishing THE TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY EQUIPMENT TRUST, SERIES BB, hereby certifies (a) that all of the \$11,400,000 principal amount of Equipment Trust Certificates, dividends thereon and dividend warrants appertaining thereto, issued under the Equipment Trust have been fully paid, and (b) all of the obligations under the Equipment Trust Agreement have been fully complied with and performed.

WHEREFORE, in consideration of \$1.00 and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, CHEMICAL BANK, as Trustee, does hereby declare the Equipment Trust Agreement, including all amendments and supplements thereto, comprising THE TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY EQUIPMENT TRUST, SERIES BB, to be SATISFIED, RELEASED AND CANCELLED and does consent that the Trust be released and discharged of record, and further, does hereby SELL, ASSIGN, CONVEY, TRANSFER, SET OVER, RELEASE AND QUITCLAIM unto THE TEXAS AND PACIFIC RAILWAY, as its absolute property, all of
