INTERSTATE COMMERCE COMMISSION

THIS ASSIGNMENT, dated as of December 31, 1980, by and between GREENLEASE COMPANY, a Division of Greenville Steel Car Company, a Pennsylvania corporation (the "Assignor"), and GREENVILLE LEASING COMPANY, a Delaware corporation (the "Assignee"), and consented to by CERTAINTEED CORPORATION, a Maryland corporation ("Certain-Teed");

WHEREAS, the Assignor and PPG Industries, Inc. ("PPG") heretofore entered into a Railroad Car Lease Agreement dated as of March 1, 1971 (the "Lease"), whereby the Assignor leased to PPG 3 /00 Ton 86' 6" High Cube Box Cars, Road Nos. PPGX 15005 to 15007, both inclusive (the "Cars"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Novation Agreement executed as of April 1, 1973, the Lease was amended to substitute Certain-Teed (then called "Certain-Teed Products Corporation") as Lessee under the Lease, and to change the Road Nos. of the Cars to CPTX 15005 to 15007, both inclusive, and

WHEREAS, the Assignor desires to assign its interest in the Lease and its interest in the Cars to the Assignee, with the consent of Certain-Teed, as hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and other good and valuable consideration the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto, intending to be legally bound hereby, do agree as follows:

1. Effective as of December 31, 1980 Assignor hereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto the Assignee:

- (a) All the Assignor's right, title and interest, powers, privileges and other benefits under the Lease, as amended, which shall arise or accrue after December 31, 1980; and
- (b) All the Assignor's right, title and interest in the Cars.

Assignor further agrees to execute and deliver such instrument or instruments, confirming the transfer of title to the Cars to the Assignee, as Assignee may reasonably request.

- 2. Assignee hereby accepts the foregoing assignment, recognizes Certain-Teed's right to continued and uninterrupted possession of the Cars upon compliance with the terms of the Lease, as amended, and assumes and undertakes to perform all the obligations of Assignor as the Lessor under the Lease, as amended.
- 3. For purposes of paragraph 16 of the Lease, as amended, Assignee's address as Lessor shall be as follows:

- 4. Certain-Teed hereby consents and agrees to the assignment provided for in paragraph 1 above.
- 5. All the terms, covenants and provisions of the Lease, as amended, shall continue in full force and effect precisely as before.
- 6. This Assignment may be simultaneously executed in two or more counterparts each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts together

shall constitute but one and the same instrument which shall be sufficiently evidenced by any such original counterpart.
