SATISFACTION AND RELEASE

This Satisfaction and Release, dated as of January 1, 1982, by and between SOO LINE RAILROAD COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the state of Minnesota, with its principal office and place of business in the Soo Line Building, city of Minneapolis, Minnesota (hereinafter sometimes called the "Buyer"), and FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF MINNEAPOLIS, a national banking association duly incorporated and existing under the laws of the United States of America, with its principal place of business in the city of Minneapolis, Minnesota (hereinafter called "Assignee"), WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Buyer and Assignee are parties to that certain Agreement and Assignment dated as of December 31, 1971, relating to that certain Conditional Sale Agreement, dated as of December 31, 1971, covering the purchase by Buyer of 70 gondola cars; and

WHEREAS, Buyer has paid the full purchase price for said gondola cars, together with interest and any and all other payments required by said Conditional Sale Agreement, and all other covenants and conditions of Buyer contained therein have been fully performed by Buyer;
