WHEREAS, heretofore, on the fifteenth day of February, 1972, an Equipment Lease (the "Lease") was executed by Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company, predecessor in interest to the Soo Line Railroad Company ("Mortgagor"), in favor of Union Trust Company of Maryland ("Lessor"); and

WHEREAS, the Mortgage was duly recorded with the Interstate Commerce Commission ("ICC") on February 22, 1972, and assigned Recordation Number 6506-A; and

WHEREAS, the Lease was supplemented by First through Eighth Supplements, dated May 30, July 5, August 21, September 25, October 16, November 6 and December 4, 1972 and January 8, 1973; and

WHEREAS, the said First through Eighth Supplements were recorded at the ICC on May 30, July 5, August 21, September 26, October 16, and November 6, 1972 and January 8, 1973 and assigned Recordation Numbers 6506-B through 6506-I inclusive; and

WHEREAS, the Lease and the Supplements thereto granted Lessor a valid security interest in certain equipment of Lessee, specifically eighteen (18) General Motors rebuilt GP20 type diesel-electric road switcher locomotives (the

"Locomotives") fully described as follows;

Lessor makes no warranties of any kind hereby, and shall not be held liable to Lessee, its successors, assigns, or parties to whom Lessee has transferred its interest in the Locomotives, for any cause whatsoever because of the execution hereof.


This Release may be simultaneously executed in a number of counterparts, each of which so executed shall be deemed to be an original, and such counterparts together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
